Parents and Guardians,

We hope you are all enjoying your summer! Our staff is excited to have our students back for our upcoming 2021-2022 school year! There are a few important items we wanted to share below that pertain to the new school year.

1. School will begin Tuesday, August 31 at 8:00 am. Doors will open at 7:50 am and will be the same time throughout the year. Please do not drop your student off before this time, they will not be permitted in the building.
2. Free breakfast and lunch will be offered to all students. Breakfast will continue to be grab and go and students will eat in their classroom like last year.
3. If you need to bring anything to your student during the day, our front office will be available to help with those needs. Parents and guardians will not be allowed in any classrooms.
4. If you need to set up transportation, please make contact with the school. Our transportation director, Mr. Sancrant, will be available at our open house for further questions on times and locations etc.
5. We will not be requiring masks or temperature checks at this time. Keep in mind this could change at any time in the school year, and we will update parents.
6. Open House for all students and parents will be Thursday, August 26 from 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm where students will get their class schedule, locker information and will be able to meet their teacher(s).
7. Class supply lists are posted on our school website: cpseagles.org under school info, select elementary or middle/high school.
8. School will continue to dismiss early on Fridays at 1:50 pm. (Unless it is scheduled as a half day on the calendar.)
9. The regular school day Monday through Thursday will go from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm. All scheduled half days will run from 8:00 am to 11:20 am.
10. Secondary students will go back to switching classrooms throughout the day. Elementary students will also switch classes for their specials time.
11. Students in band class will be using instruments this year.
12. Homework Center will be available Monday-Thursday for secondary students starting Monday, September 13 from 3:05 pm to 4:00 pm in the school library.
13. New this year: All K-12 students, except Tech Center students, will take part in SOAR time. This is a 20 minute session Monday-Thursday where students will be split into small groups to work on a wide range of items, such as interventions, enrichments, future planning etc. Elementary SOAR time will be in the morning and secondary SOAR time will be in the afternoon. Students will receive more details on the first day of school.
