Board Goals 2017-2021

Mission Statement:

Caseville Public School, united with parents and community, is continuously igniting the desire to learn, instilling knowledge, and meeting the needs of all students in their pursuit of excellence.

Board Goal Area #1: Student Achievement:

The Board of Education will support the development and implementation of district wide school improvement process and educational practices resulting in 100% of Caseville third grader students scoring proficient on the state approved standardized test by 2020. Also, all other grades will have test scores at or above the state average.

Objective:

1. Starting in 2018, Caseville Public School will increase test scores in every subject from the previous year and increase test scores by 3% to 5% in each subsequent year while staying above the state average in all subject areas at each grade level on MI-Step, MME, and SAT.
2. Every student will show demonstrate academic growth as evidenced by our local data in Dibbles, teacher pre and posttest, and other local assessments.

Board Goal Area #2: Community Relations:

Caseville Public School will build positive and effective community relations.

Objective:

1. By the fall of 2017 Caseville Public School will increase parent and community involvement opportunities. Offer four or more parent events and activities at the building level.
2. By the fall of 2018 Caseville Public School will increase forms of communication between home and school. The building level will establish three or more avenues of communication that can be documented.

Board Goal Area #3: Fiscal Responsibility:

Caseville Public School will maintain the financial integrity and transparency of our district while providing quality programs that meet or exceed the needs of all students.

Objective:

1. Explore refinancing of bonds and the expansion / upgrading of facilities through the bonding process.

2. The school district seeks to maintain a minimum unassigned balance in its general fund ranging from fifteen (15%) to twenty (20%) percent of subsequent year's budgeted expenditures and outgoing transfers.
3. Transparent, long range and student-centered budget planning that includes a balanced budget over the next four years.
4. Consolidation and cooperative use of all services / facilities.
5. Prioritizing funds in order to support the continued professional development of all staff.
6. Successful adoption of a new three year teaching contract.
7. Enhance building usage.

Board Goal Area #4: Specific to members of the Board of Education:

The Caseville Board of Education will hold itself to the highest standard possible out of respect to the school and community that we serve.

Objectives:

1. The members of the Board will participate in education opportunities and workshops offered to them.
2. The members of the Board will see themselves as contributing members of the education community.
