1. The 2020-21 School Year is scheduled to begin September 8th.
2. Sub-committees have met over the past few weeks regarding specific details surrounding the 2020-21 school year. Committees include a Scheduling, Distance Learning, Technology, Food Service, Hygiene and Transportation Committee. State and local Health Departments have been consulted as well.
